Strategic Approach

Place based resilience, co-designed by KI business community

Launch risk reduction tool focused on community-led theme Opportunities for sustained growth & ongoing participation

Theme - Climate Adaptation

Local Steering Committee of 18 voted between 3 possible themes with "Climate Adaptation" decided as the focus most beneficial to Kangaroo Island business people. This preference was validated by interactions in our Risky Business Workshop.

- Collect data to inform questions



Findings

- Climate adaptation knowledge is siloed with Ag sector showing significant capabilities
- Insurance information and guidance are wanted
- Peer-to-peer supported micro-learning really resonated with a fatigued community
- Business community has room to be better connected and is ready to take the next step

Understand Your Business

- 5% don't know their essential operations
- 57% don't have 3 or more revenue streams
- 33% don't have a supply chain back up plan
- 48% don't know how climate change will impact their essential ops

Know Your Risks


- 33% don't think they could survive another disaster
- 14% don't know KI-related business hazards
- 19% can't rate potential risks high to low
- 14% don't take positive risks in their business

Plan Your Response

- 71% don't have a climate adaptation plan for essential operations
- 71% don't have an exit plan for the business
- 43% aren't sure they have the right insurance type/amount
- 24% don't have the right people structure to effectively operate

Build Your Networks

- 75% don't have a disaster preparedness plan with next door business
- 38% don't collaborate with competitors
- 38% don't co-design with other KI businesses
- 43% aren't a member of a KI business network


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


